RHAM ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP FEES:

Family Membership: \$40

Individual Membership: \$25

Youth Membership: \$15

• Exhibitors must be current RHAM Members to show at any RHAM shows

ARHA MEMBERSHIP:

• Both the owner and the exhibitor must be current ARHA members to show (except Walk/Trot, RHAM Open Cutting, and Leadline)

• All horses must have current ARHA Certificate of Eligibility to show (except Walk/Trot, RHAM Open Cutting, and Leadline)

ARHA Membership/Horse Registration accepted at show, will be assessed a \$10 rush fee per application

Grade registrations can be taken at shows (See 2024-2025 ARHA Rulebook)

IMPORTANT SHOW INFORMATION

• Class registration(s) for the first four (4) classes of each day must be completed 30 minutes prior to show start time

- To be eligible for RHAM Year End Class Awards, the exhibitor must show in the nominated class at 3 of the 4 RHAM pointed shows.
- To be eligible for all other RHAM Year End Awards, exhibitor must show at 3 of the 4 RHAM pointed shows.
- All awards for Open Division are based on points for the horse only.

• All awards based on one horse/one exhibitor/division combination for Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth, and Novice Youth

- Open, Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth, and Novice Youth Divisions require current ARHA Horse Certificate of Eligibility, current ARHA Membership Card, and current ARHA Amateur, Novice Amateur, or Youth Card (or copies).
- Western attire is required for <u>all</u> classes; for details refer to the 2024-2025 ARHA Rulebook (available at www.americanranchhorse.net)
- All classes judged according to ARHA rules; judges' decision is final

RHAM PRE-ENTRY:

• Pre-entries can be submitted by Midnight on Monday the week of the show. Link on the RHAM website, miranchhorse.com

RHAM WEEKEND HIGH POINT SERIES:

• RHAM Weekend High Point Series awards will be awarded based on points earned in all ARHA classes in one Division: Open, Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth, Novice Youth. Open Division are based on points for the horse only.

RHAM AWARD PROGRAM:

- Eligible Divisions: Open, Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth, and Novice Youth
- Points are based on one horse/one rider combination in each division. Open Division are based on points for the horse only.
- Exhibitors may choose to show in as many classes and any combination of classes within each program. Not all classes are required for Year End Award eligibility.
- For each program, points for all eligible classes will be accumulated for each horse/rider combination from all 4 pointed RHAM shows to determine division placings.
- If a division does not contain an eligible class, the exhibitor is not required to 'show up' to accumulate points (ie. Novice Amateur exhibitor will not be required to show in an Amateur Working Ranch Horse class). Only classes available within the division that are eligible classes will be considered for point standings.

TOP RANCH HAND

Points will accumulate in the following classes for each division:

• Ranchmanship, Ranch Reining, Ranch Boxing, Ranch Cutting, Ranch Roping, Working Ranch Horse, Ranch Riding, Ranch Trail

TOP COW HORSE

Points will accumulate in the following classes for each division:

• Herd Work, Ranch Boxing, Ranch Cutting, Ranch Roping, Working Ranch Horse

TOP PERFORMANCE HORSE

Points will accumulate in the following classes for each division:

• Ranchmanship, Ranch Showmanship, Ranch Reining, Horsemanship, Ranch Riding, Ranch Trail

RHAM LAMINATED BACK NUMBERS: Last Date to Reserve 2024 Back Numbers is May 12 (Last day of the May show).

Purchase laminated back numbers with horse and exhibitor names on them. For those showing multiple horses, this is a great way to help remember each horse's number and it also helps when pre-entering for the shows by having a pre-assigned number. You can select 2 or 3 back number tags; a third (3rd) back number tag eliminates the step of removing a number from your saddle pad to attach to the back of your show shirt for your conformation and/or showmanship classes. Back numbers are assigned to horses. Form available on website to purchase back numbers.
